## Mardi Gras Formal Banquet Attire Guide

*You do not have to follow the theme for your banquet attire. Mess Dress or Service Dress are expected for those that do not wish to follow this year's theme.*

### Mardi Gras Formal Attire for Males: Costume de Rigueur or Black Tie

**Costume de Rigueur** (white tie formal)- full dress, complete with black tail coat, white pique shirt, vest and bow tie. Black patent leather shoes should be worn. Masks are encouraged but not required.

**Black tie**- black tuxedo jacket and matching trousers with a black bow tie and black cummerbund or vest. Black patent leather shoes should be worn. Masks are encouraged but not required.

**Loud suit/tuxedo**- suit or tuxedo in Mardi Gras patterns or colors. Masks are encouraged but not required.

### Mardi Gras Formal Attire for Females:

A floor length or ankle length gown is appropriate to wear, traditional colors are Green (representing faith), Gold (representing power), and Purple (representing justice) though not required. No bare midriff dresses, tea length, or handkerchief skirt dresses. Masks are encouraged but not required.
